More than **90%** of students participating agreed that they want to try their best to **avoid the use of drugs**.

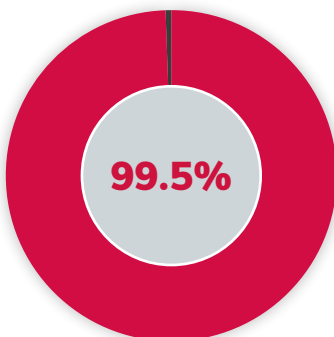
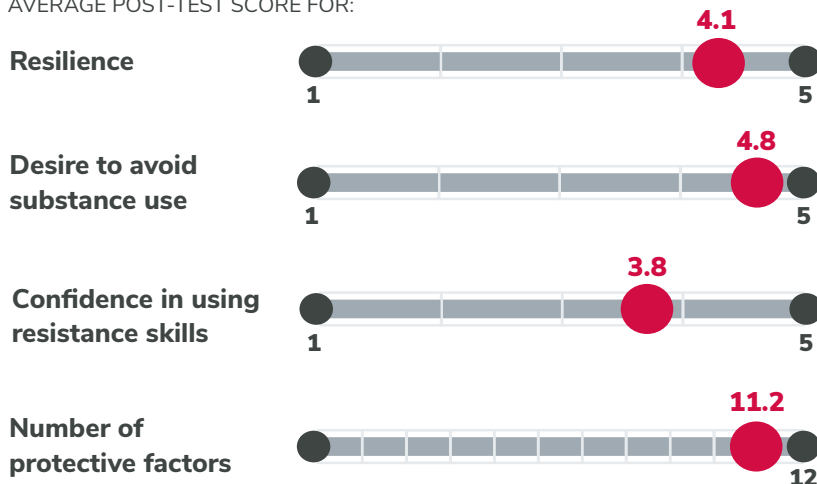

Ohio Level Data



313 students participated at **5 schools** across 3 counties in Ohio



The majority of students participating experienced more than **6 protective factors**.



Data suggested that a small proportion of students, **6.3%**, may be **at-risk for substance use** and **associated harm** based on expressed ambivalence or disagreed that they desired to avoid substance use.



Data indicated **little change** from pre-intervention to post-intervention. Students with very few exceptions had high resiliency and protective factors scores on the post-test including desire to avoid substance use and confidence in using drug resistance scores.



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
